

## **Riverview Emergency Center Expansion Fact Sheet**



- **\$11.5 million**
- **63,000 square feet**
- **Grand Opening: July 2006**
- **Riverview projects its Emergency patient volume will at least double over the next 10 years; Riverview saw 22,000 patients in 2005**
- **The building expansion and program updates are being designed to streamline care for urgent and non-urgent treatment, as well as to provide more satisfactory experiences for patients, physicians and EMS-providers**
- **The Center will offer separate patient areas for acute patient needs and urgent patient needs; also to offer bedside registration**
- **The current department size is about 5,000 square feet; the new addition will result in an Emergency Center approximately 15,000 square feet with an additional 9,000 square feet common area**
- **The Center will have 10 acute care rooms, 2 resuscitation rooms, 2 secure hold rooms, 2 female exam rooms, 6 express care rooms, and 5 diagnostic and therapeutic rooms**
- **The spacious lobby area will feature a private Radio Disney Family Fun Room for kids, comfortable seating and wireless internet access**
- **The expansion is 3 stories; first floor is Emergency; second and third floors are approximately 20,000 square feet each and will be available for future expansion**
- **Riverview has contracted with the physicians of Riverview Emergency Medical Group Inc. since summer of 2003 to provide treatment for emergency patients**
- **Riverview EMGI physicians are specialty trained in emergency medicine; a pediatric emergency trained physician also is on staff**
- **Browning Day Mullins Dierdorf Architects is the project architect and has partnered with META Associates in planning and design; Browning Day has completed over 100 emergency department projects across the United States**
- **The Center was designed with input from Emergency Medical Technicians and Paramedics; Riverview staff and physicians; and the general public**
- **Meyer Najem is the general contractor**
